# Dragon's Den Sketch Written by Oz Durose

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Three 'DRAGONS' sit on three chairs on stage. They have stacks or bags of money on the table. The 'DRAGONS' will not be named, only referred to as DRAGON A, DRAGON B and DRAGON C for means of the script. To the stage right, a man in a suit (HOPEFORD) sykes himself up before confronting the DRAGONS. The screen shows a picture of the Dragon's Den logo.

HOPEFORD turns to greet the DRAGONS.

### HOPEFORD

Good evening, Dragons. My name is HOPEFORD HOPEINGTON, and today I am looking for TEN THOUSAND POUNDS for a TWENTY PERCENT SHARE of my carbonated beverage company, 'HOPE'.

HOPE has been running for generations, and has been doing exceptionally well; We have released a range of products which you may have seen advertised.

HOPE MAXX, the drink for the wishful thinker, HOPE NOIR, for the realistic pessimist, and our current best seller, HOPE ZERO, for the complete no hoper.

Our HOPE TECHNICIANS have been working hard on a new product. With your investment, I believe we could truly change the world. We believe that we have finally perfected the recipe for that pure HOPE taste that the public have been searching for.

Today I present to you 'HOPE ORIGINAL'.

Plays the Hope Original advert.

## DRAGON C

I like your advert, but it's lacking impact? They should high-five at the end.

#### DRAGON A

Ooh, yes! That would be great! A nice high-five moment, then freezeframe!

## **HOPEFORD**

Well... I suppose I could fit that in ...?

#### DRAGON B

Now, I'm just going to be straight with you. You seem like a nice chap, but I think you're deluded.

I am familiar with your products, but this?
I just can't get behind it!
I'm more of a HOPE ZERO kind of man, and I think this entire premise is silly.
I don't believe in you, I don't believe in the direction of your company, and I certainly don't believe in your product,

#### DRAGON B

# DRAGON C

Listen, you're out! You don't get to ask any more questions!
But that is a good point. What proof do you have?

Our market research show that after drinking HOPE ORIGINAL, customers feel an overall optimism.

## DRAGON A

But how does it work?

# **HOPEFORD**

Well, it gives you a confidence in the future by setting realistic goals and plotting pathways to help you achieve them.

## DRAGON C

Hmmm... and how much are you selling this for? What's the price per unit?

#### HOPEFORD

Ah... well... you see, I believe HOPE ORIGINAL should be made readily available for everyone. I know that this will change the world for the better.

And for that reason I believe it should be free.

DRAGON B

Free!?

#### DRAGON A

Quiet you! Free!?!

## DRAGON C

... wouldn't I?

I don't know. Maybe I am deluded. Maybe

this is a ridiculous idea.

HOPEFORD, disheartened, looks at the CAN of HOPE ORIGINAL in his hand. With a sigh he opens it and takes a few mouthfuls. He becomes optimistic.

## HOPEFORD

NO! This is a great idea! And we can change the world! All I need is the correct investor...

I'm sure the Dragons will come to their senses!

You know what? I'll try again next week! Ahhh, Hope! Original!
